# Cyber Security, Privacy, & Data Protection Trainings

Title	Time to Complete	Description
Cybersecurity and Online Habits	Approximately 60-minutes	This course focuses on the common IT security pitfalls by end users and provides workers with guidelines on how to manage the risks associated with these pitfalls.
Data Protection and Device Security	Approximately 60-minutes	This course focuses on how workers can keep company data secure, even when working remotely.
Privacy Concerns	Approximately 20-minutes	This course is focused on Personally Identifiable Information (PII). Workers will review what PII is, how to identify privacy considerations, the GDPR and CCPA.
Australia Cybersecurity	Approximately 20-minutes	This course is designed specifically to focus on protecting data under Australian law, while providing workers with information on common IT security risks and the forms that they take.
New Zealand Cybersecurity	Approximately 20-minutes	This course is designed specifically to focus on protecting data under New Zealand law, while providing workers with information on common IT security risks and the forms that they take.
Canada's Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA)	Approximately 20-minutes	This course shows workers the important concepts of PIPEDA, the rights individuals have under the act, and keys to compliance with the law.
California Consumer Privacy Law – CCPA & CPRA	Approximately 40-minutes	This course is focused on the California Privacy Rights Act (CPRA) and the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA). It showcases the types of businesses and information protected by these laws, and provides workers both in and out of California a better understanding of the laws terms.
Ethical Use of AI in the Workplace	Approximately 40-minutes	This course provides workers with information on how AI can and should be used in the workplace by exploring the common uses and benefits of AI, along with the potential for bias in AI and global regulations.
UK Data Protection Laws	Approximately 25-minutes	This course outlines the purpose and principles of the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the obligations of controllers and processors under the regulations.
